New Families Orientation

Our orientation night takes place on **Thursday, August 11 from 6-7:30 pm,** beginning in Lakeshore's Community Room. Please bring your child; the entire family is welcome to attend.

- Children entering Kindergarten will visit their new class with their teacher and classmates. You will also visit your child's teacher in the classroom and hear about the wonderful year ahead. This is a very important way to help children transition into their new school. Details are included on a separate flyer.
- Children entering grades 1-5 will attend the assembly and go on a tour of the school. You and your child will be able to see the classroom and get a teacher assignment, though their teachers will not be present. There is a Back-to-School Night for grades 1-5 after the first couple of weeks of school. Regardless, all family members and guardians are invited to New Families Orientation night. We want to meet you!

Forms to Return

This packet includes forms that need to be filled out and returned on orientation night:

- Questionnaire and Readiness survey about your child, for their teacher.
- After-School Arrangements form. It is absolutely essential that your child's classroom teacher knows what arrangements are for after school.

The Start of School

- School starts on Monday, August 15.
- Students may be on the yard from 9:15 a.m. when supervision starts. Dismissal is at 3:35 p.m.
- The ExCEL and Everyday Magic after-school programs start on the first day of school *if* your child has an application on file *and has been accepted* into one of these programs.
- Please make sure your child is clear on dismissal instructions for the first week of school. This can eliminate many difficulties at the end of busy learning days.
- If you are picking up your child, please be early or on time on the K yard. If you are running late, you will find your child in the main office as teachers often have meetings after school.

Expectations

- At Lakeshore, we expect students to be safe, be respectful and be responsible. Your child's teacher and the rest of the staff will help your child to understand exactly what that looks like in the yard, in the classroom, in the halls, and everywhere around school.
- Please label back packs, lunch items and jackets with your child's name so they don't get lost on the first day of school.
