- Follow directions from every adult.



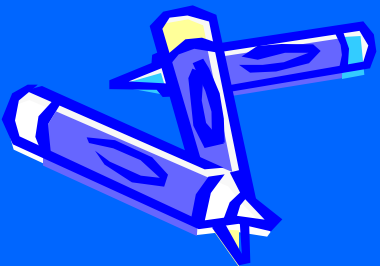
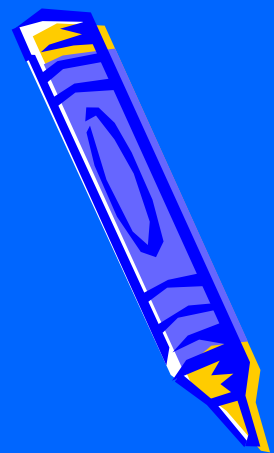
Responsibility

- Be safe.

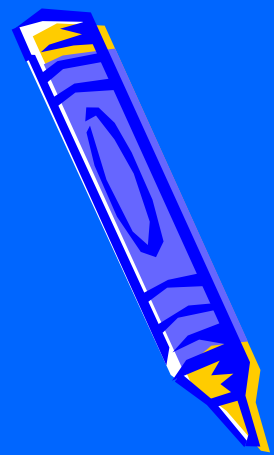


Respect ≠ Teasing

Lakeshore is a nice school.

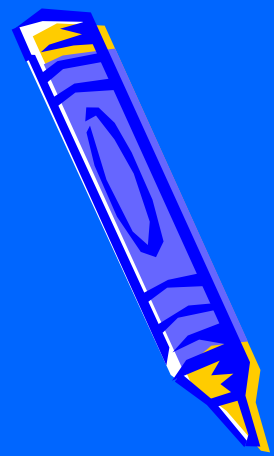
All Lakeshore students are nice.

bullying at Lakeshore?



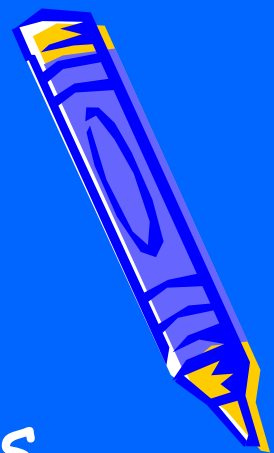
Episode 1
