Standards Based Report Cards

Standards Based Report Cards give parents information about their children's achievement. They list the most important skills students should learn in a subject for a particular grade level. Instead of letter grades, students receive marks that show how well they have mastered a skill. The student is not competing against other students. The student's performance level is indicated in the following table.

Performance Level Description

- 1 Need more time/practice to develop.
- 2 Approaching the standard
- 3 Meets the standard
- 4 Exceeds the standard
- / Not assessed this quarter

All students are expected to meet the standard (performance level 3) by the end of the school year for each skill or standard. It is important to note that the grade level standards on the Standards Based Report Cards are what students should know and be able to do by the end of the year! The Performance Level Descriptors are not to be seen as failures, but rather, how your child is performing.

Parents are encouraged to use Standards
Based Report Cards to identify ways to support
their child's academic success. Student
engagement and student achievement are
everyone's responsibility. If a student is not
Exceeding (4) or Meeting (3) a standard,
