- Prizes. LOTS of prizes!

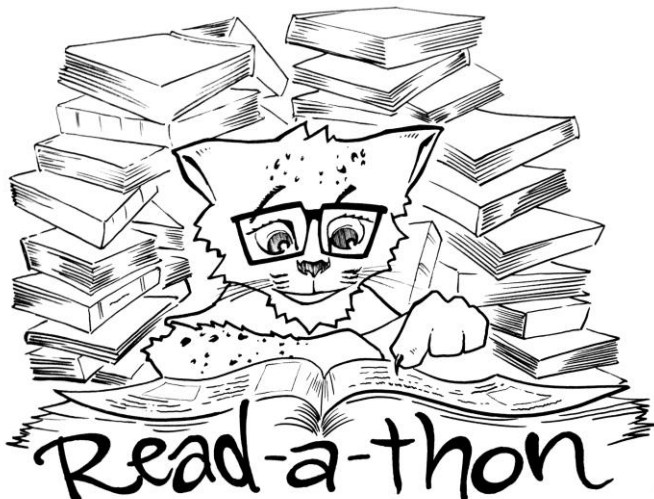
Food will be available for purchase – dinner, snacks, treats and drinks.
