Many people stayed for the first PTA meeting, which had some wonderful discussion. The conversation centered on the annual budget and the group learned about the difference between the Core Enrichment programs (those which run all year) and the "Pool" programs (8 total hours, with specific offerings chosen by the teachers). Martha Luna provided more detail on the innovative Gardening / Environment Science Core Enrichment Program – offered to all Lakeshore students. Marlene Bazdarich is now leading the Motor Core Enrichment Program and discussed how this program will be changing this year. The membership voted to pay the Consultants and reimburse parents for expenses incurred for this year, prior to the vote on the budget in October. A great conversation was had regarding the fundraising ideas and volunteering.
