# Afternoon Mandarin Program (AMP) – Now Enrolling

Designed for BOTH English-speakers and Mandarinspeakers, students will develop fundamental communication and literacy skills in one of the world's most spoken languages. Students are picked up by our teachers at 3:30 pm for snacks before class begins at 3:55pm. During class, students experience Chinese language and culture through activities such as poetry, singing, arts and crafts, and writing. AMP has 2 levels: Beginner (no experience required) and Intermediate/Advanced for students who know basic phonics and some writing skills. Program tuition is \$475/\$450 semester for 5/4 days a week plus \$20 book fee and non-refundable, one-time \$30 registration fee. Sibling discounts of \$25/semester are available. # Morning Language Programs – Now Enrolling

The Morning Cantonese Program (MCP) was created in 1986 by parents at Lakeshore Elementary to promote Chinese language skills and culture. Classes take place from 8:15-9:15 a.m. on school days in the Community Room. The curriculum includes singing, Chinese dancing, Tai Chi, poetry, reading, writing, and arts and crafts.
