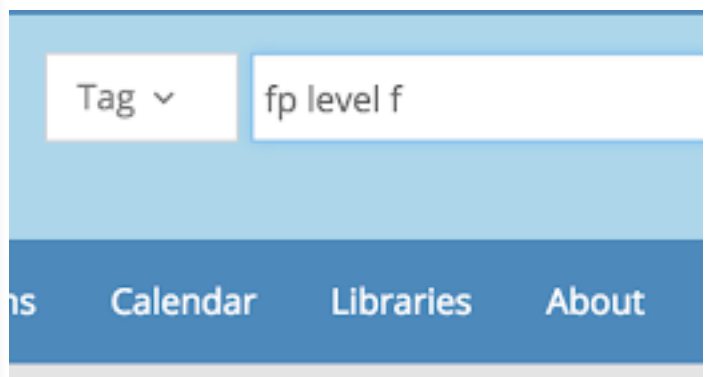

Find F&P Leveled Books at the San Francisco Public Library

Your child's teacher may have notified you of your child's F&P (Fountas & Pinnell) reading level. Our teachers use these reading levels (ranging from A to Z) to identify the books that are right for our kids. But books in bookstores and libraries are not organized by F&P reading levels, making it hard to find books the books our kids need. The San Francisco Public Library has stepped in to help. You may now search the SFPL catalog by the tag "fp level." Not every book is tagged by F&P level but many are, especially in the lower grade levels (A-N).

To search sfpl.org, choose the category "Tag" and enter "fp level" and then the letter, as below. You can also narrow by library location to just see what's available at your branch.
