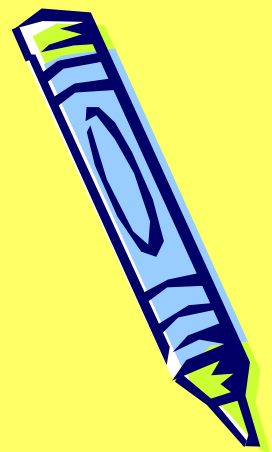


# How do Lakeshore Students Feel at School?

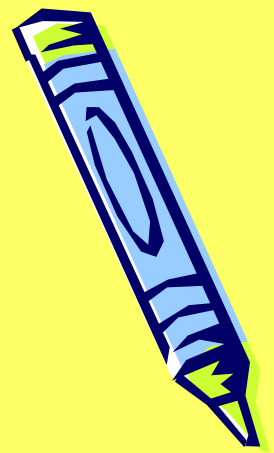
Student Survey Results - 84 Respondents

• Don't Know	5%	



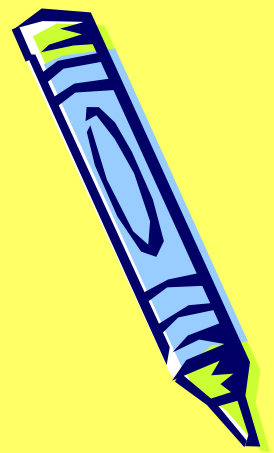
# Student Survey Results

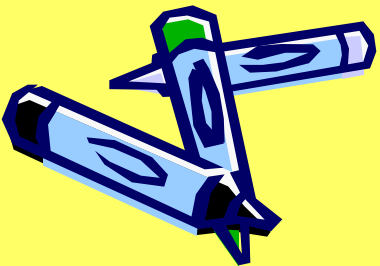

## Have friends at school

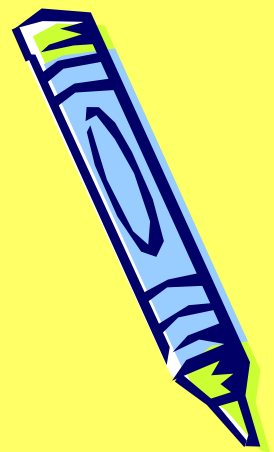

## I love my school!

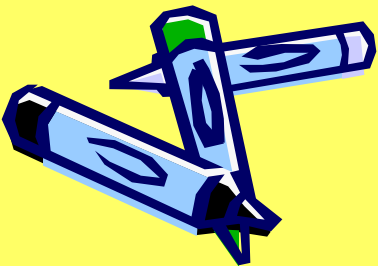
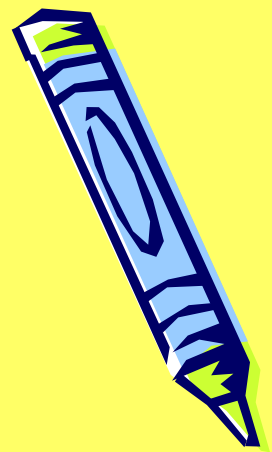

- Lack of respect for *all* adults.

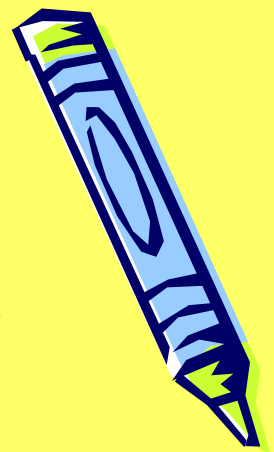

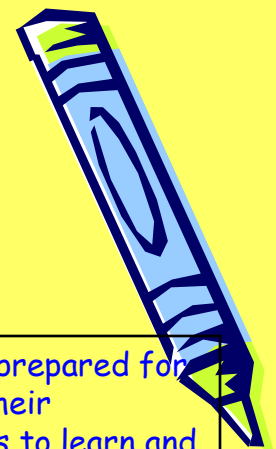

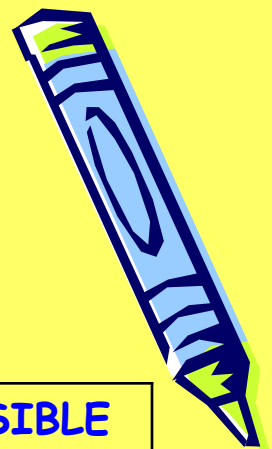
# Respect Bingo

<p>Students steal items from a teacher and lie about what happened.</p>	<p>Teacher hears a student talking during a lesson and tells them to be quiet and student denies talking at all.</p>	<p>Teacher asks students to pick their papers and pencils off the floor. Students say they didn't drop anything on the floor.</p>	<p>Students cooperate with the Coach, the supervisors and the yard duty teachers during recess and lunch time.</p>
<p>Student was asked to pick a wrapper that missed the garbage can when he threw it and he kept walking with his friends.</p>	<p>Students are quiet and raise the quiet signal when the noon supervisor asks for everyone's attention in the cafeteria.</p>	<p>Students eat food in the common areas only and never sneak food onto the yard.</p>	<p>Students are helpful when a sub comes to their class by following their daily schedule and monitoring their own behavior.</p>

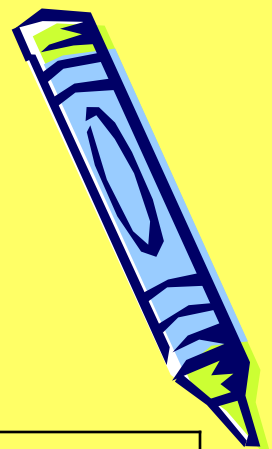

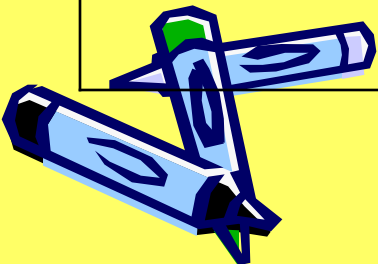

All Common Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself</li> <li>Get adult help when needed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use kind words and actions</li> <li>Keep Lakeshore clean</li> <li>Listen and follow directions</li> <li>Wait your turn</li> <li>Follow adult directions</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Follow Lakeshore expectations</li> <li>Take care of all belongings and school equipment</li> </ul>
Cafeteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sit with your class facing the table.</li> <li>Keep food to self (no throwing food)</li> <li>Get an adult in case of a spill</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use quiet voices</li> <li>Allow anyone to sit next to you</li> <li>Line up properly after eating</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Raise hand and wait to be excused</li> <li>Get all utensils, etc. when first going through the line</li> <li>Line up quietly</li> </ul>
Playground/ Recess	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Walk to and from the playground</li> <li>Play on play structure in the appropriate way.</li> <li>Keep your hands and feet to yourself</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wait your turn in line</li> <li>Climb on the playstructure, one at a time without shoving or pushing</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Play only in assigned areas</li> <li>At the signal or bell, students must freeze, wait for the whistle and walk quietly to class</li> <li>Eat only in the patio area</li> <li>Use quiet voices near classrooms in sessions</li> </ul>
Bathrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep feet on the floor</li> <li>Keep water in the sink</li> <li>Wash your hands</li> <li>Put towels in the garbage can, not on the ceiling or in the toilet</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Knock on the stall door</li> <li>Give people privacy</li> <li>Use quiet voices</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Flush toilet after use</li> <li>Return to room promptly</li> <li>Use a bathroom pass</li> </ul>
Arrival and Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wait in designated areas</li> <li>Use the sidewalks and crosswalks</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(See All Common Areas)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Arrive on time</li> <li>Get homework and leave on time</li> </ul>
