


 Don't Know 	5%












Student Survey Results Have friends at school


- No 2%

A student gets angry at another student and calls out a name that refers to race or appearance.	Student gets a detention during lunch recess for not doing an assignment and plays with friends instead.	Student gers beat up for laughing at another student.	Students are prepared for ELD by their eagerness to learn and their willingness to follow directions from their new teacher.
Students steal items from a teacher and lie about what happened.	Teacher hears a student talking during a lesson and tells them to be quiet and student denies talking at all.	Teacher asks students to pick their papers and pencils off the floor. Students say they didn't drop anything on the floor.	Students cooperate with the Coach, the supervisors and the yard duty teachers during recess and lunch time.


